The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract contained in the bidding documents comply with the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act [Chapter 22:23]. The Procurement method applicable for the bidding process shall be National Competitive Bidding. Prospective Bidders must be registered with the Procurement Regulatory Authority of Zimbabwe (PRAZ).

Currency

Bids should be priced in United States Dollars or any other freely convertible currency. The currency of evaluation will be United States Dollars. Bids in other currencies will be converted to this currency (United States Dollars) for evaluation purposes only, using the exchange rates published by the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe on the date of the submission deadline, see <http://www.rbz.co.zw/>. The actual payment will be in RTGS dollars/ local currency convertible from United States Dollars at the applicable interbank exchange rate (the going rate).

This opportunity is open to Zimbabwean companies only. Bidders are not required to pay any administration fees payable by bidders to the Procurement Regulatory Authority of Zimbabwe for this tender.

Bidding Documents will be available electronically upon a written request to procurement@idbz.co.zw. Bids shall be valid for a bid period of 120 days.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope and deposited in the tender box located at the address mentioned above and shall be endorsed on the outside with the advertised tender number, description and closing date.

No faxed, e-mailed or late tenders will be considered. The IDBZ is not obliged to accept the lowest bid, or any bid. Bids will be opened in the presence of bidder's representatives who choose to attend at 10:00hours local time (Central African Time) on or before submission deadline date, at the above stated offices.
