The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract contained in the bidding documents comply with the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act [Chapter 22:23]. The Procurement method applicable for the bidding process shall be National Competitive Bidding. **Prospective Bidders must be registered with the Procurement Regulatory Authority of Zimbabwe (PRAZ)**.

This opportunity is open to Zimbabwean companies only. Bidders are not required to pay an administration fee payable by Bidders to the Procurement Regulatory Authority of Zimbabwe. The payments are in line with Section 54 of the Act as set out in Part IV of the Fifth Schedule to the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Regulations (SI 5 of 2018).

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope and deposited in the tender box located at the address mentioned above and shall be endorsed on the outside with the advertised tender number, description and closing date.

**No faxed, e-mailed or late tenders will be considered.** Bids will be opened in the presence of bidder's representatives who choose to attend at 10:00hours local time (Central African Time) on or before submission deadline date, at the above stated offices.

All bidders are invited to the opening of tenders immediately after closing on the stipulated dates and times for the respective tenders. Attendance to the closing and opening is not compulsory, and any member of the public may attend at their own free will.
