

COVID19 INCIDENT STATEMENT

As a precautionary measure, the Infrastructure Development Bank of Zimbabwe (the IDBZ) arranged for its Staff to undertake the Covid-19 PCR Test. Results received reveal that of the 80 staff members tested, six are positive. The affected staff members are being attended to in line with the prescribed guidelines. The National Covid-19 Rapid Response Team have been informed and are assisting with contact tracing and appropriate interventions in line with standing Government's protocol.

In view of the outcome of the test results, all IDBZ Offices in Harare have been closed with immediate effect. The office closure will allow the Bank ample time to disinfect all its Offices. The offices will be closed from Monday, 27 July 2020 for a period of three (3) days. It is hoped that we will re-open on Thursday the 30th of July 2020.

Prior to this incident, the IDBZ was already taking preventative action in all its Offices in Harare, Bulawayo and Masvingo as guided by the Ministry of Health and the World Health Organisation to ensure the protection of our staff members and stakeholders.

We take this opportunity to assure our valued stakeholders that we remain committed to the safety of our staff and the public. We wish our colleagues and all those affected by this virus a quick and full recovery.

Further communication will be made once all the protocols for resumption of operations are in place.
